Only three people were willing to be nominated for the four open positions on the Board, so casting ballots isn't necessary. The three who were nominated will be on the slate to be presented to the membership for election to the Board at this year's Annual Meeting. When the new Board convenes, it will begin the process outlined in the by-laws to fill the vacancy on the Board. One of the issues that is unusual for this year's Board elections is that due to term limits and other factors, no incumbents were nominated for the Board. Serving on the Board is a great way to help the Co-op move into the future. We hope you will think about running for Board elections next year.

New Channels Now Available

In the past week, we have added 2 new channels to our program offerings. The Olympic Channel has programming 100% dedicated to the Olympics. Past events, current programs on athletes, events leading up to the Olympics and expanded coverage during the actual Winter and Summer Games. The Olympic Channel is part of your Expanded Basic Service and can be found automatically on Channel 135 on your Cable Box or Channel 67.2 on your Digital TV set. You must reprogram your Digital set to be able to log this channel into the memory of the set.

WDLI is an Akron-based broadcast station that is part of the Trinity Broadcast Group. Its religious-based programming is suited for the entire family. WDLI requested "Must Carry" status with the Federal Communications Commission. Since Oberlin is within the Cleveland Akron TV market, we are required by FCC rules to include the channel in our offerings. WDLI can be seen on Channel 49 in our Basic Only Service, Channel 139 on the Expanded Basic Service and Channel 49.3 on your Digital TV set.

GOOD NEWS for COZI Fans! A couple of months ago, WUAB (Cleveland) dropped carriage of COZI. We have been notified by WKYC-TV (Cleveland) that they have picked up the rights to return COZI to the Cleveland TV market. You will be able to find COZI on Channel 26 in our Basic Only Service, Channel 85 on your Cable Box and 52.14 on your Digital TV set. This was a popular channel with Oberlin Cable TV viewers and we are glad to see its return.
