



A Message From the Board of Trustees

Dear Fellow Member,

Ralph Potts, our General Manager of nearly 35 years, announced late last summer his intention to retire this June. Oberlin Cable Co-op is indebted to him and his commitment to this organization and we'll recognize his service in the coming months.

Until that time, the important work of finding our next GM must proceed. The Board of Trustees is obligated to conduct a proper, thorough search. We owe it to the membership, the current staff, and the community to identify the best individual to succeed – not replace – the only General Manager Cable Co-op has ever had. With that challenge in front of us, we've procured the services of a professional recruiting firm to guide us through the process. They've been tasked with advertising the position, handling the initial screening of applicants, and presenting the most viable candidates to the Board for interviews. The selection of our new GM will occur after the completion of those interviews, careful deliberation, and subsequent vote by the full Board.
